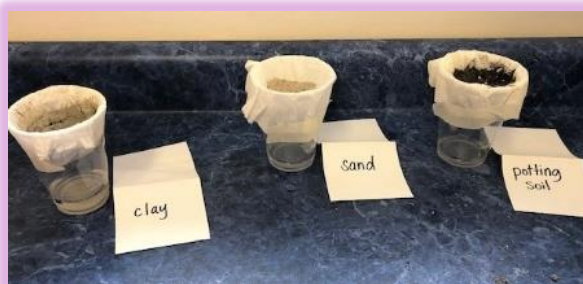
It was very special!
