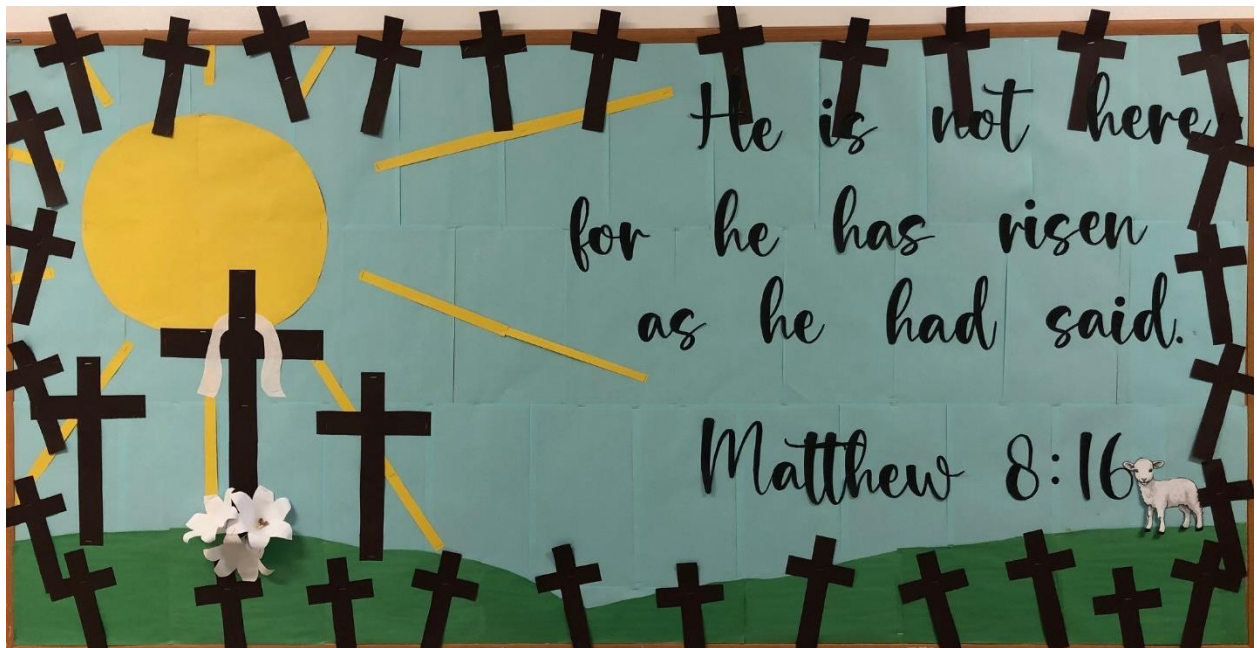


March Rock Lake School News
