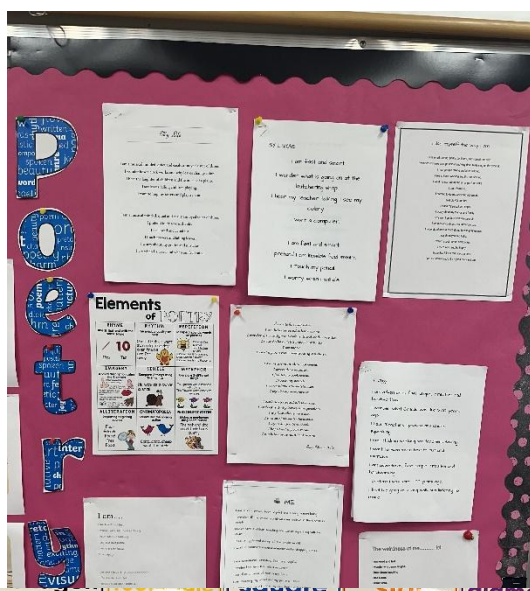


Integrating Curriculum at Omega School
